## Slaton Chamber of Commerce

The Slaton Chamber of Commerce is a 501-c3 non-profit organization that operates under the direction of a 15-member board of directors nominated from the membership. Officers are elected by the Board.

The Chamber Board meets the second Thursday of each month at noon in City Hall. We conduct activities through a series of committees comprised of directors as well as our members.

A membership in the Chamber of Commerce is an investment in Slaton.

The Slaton Chamber of Commerce members are as diverse as the city itself. They represent businesses of all sizes, industries and viewpoints. Together, we are shaping Slaton's environment and making the city a wonderful place to live, work and grow.

## Membership Dues:

An investment in the Chamber varies on the size and type of business. Investments are paid in advance on an annual basis (each January) and may be tax deductible as a business expense.

Individuals	\$30
Non-Profit (churches, schools, clubs and civic organizations)	\$75
Level 1 Business (1-15 job positions)	\$100
Level 2 Business (16 or more job positions)	\$175
Level 3 Business (Corporations, Utilities, Financial, Dealerships, etc.)	\$400

Additional Business \$20  
(Primary Business paid full membership and is equal to or larger than any additional businesses.)

Those business owners that have more than one business may add additional businesses for an annual membership fee of just \$20 each, following the payment of the primary business. The additional businesses must be equal to or less than the primary business size.
