Slaton Chamber of Commerce

The Slaton Chamber of Commerce is a 501-c3 non-profit organization that operates under the direction of a 15-member board of directors elected from the membership. Its officers are selected by the Board.

The Chamber conducts its activities through a series of committees headed by directors of the Board.

The Board meets at noon on the second Thursday of each month in the Chamber Board room at 200 W. Garza. Committees meet as needed.

Membership Dues:

An investment in the Chamber varies on the size and type of firm. Investments are paid in advance on an annual basis and may be tax deductible as a business expense.

Non-Profit \$75
(churches, schools, clubs and civic organizations)

Level 1 Business \$100
(1-15 job positions)

Level 2 Business \$175
(16 or more job positions)

Level 3 Business \$400
(Corporations, Utilities, Financial, Dealerships, etc.)

Additional Business \$20
(Primary Business paid full membership and is equal to or larger than any additional businesses.)

Those business owners that have more than one business may add those businesses for an annual membership fee of \$20 each, following the payment of the primary business. The additional businesses must be equal to or less than the primary business size.
