

## How does the "Type A" tax differ from the "Type B" tax?

### TYPE A ELIGIBLE PROJECTS

- ❖ Land, buildings, equipment, facilities, improvements, and expenditures that are for the creation and retention of primary jobs and suitable for the development, retention, or expansion of the following types of projects: manufacturing, industrial, research & development, recycling, small warehouses, distribution centers, regional or national corporate headquarters, and primary job training facilities by higher education institutions
- ❖ Job training classes for the promotion or development and expansion of business enterprises, and career centers
- ❖ Business airport facilities
- ❖ Infrastructure assistance to retail or commercial projects
- ❖ Light rail, commuter rail, or motor buses

A Type B corporation in a city with a population of 20,000 or less may provide land, buildings, equipment, facilities, expenditures, targeted infrastructure, and improvements found by the board of directors to promote new or expanded business development

### TYPE B ELIGIBLE PROJECTS

- ❖ **Everything authorized under Type A, including retail and commercial project with the same restrictions**
- ❖ Water supply facilities
- ❖ Projects that improve a community's quality of life, including parks, professional and amateur sport and athletic facilities, tourism and entertainment facilities, and affordable housing
- ❖ Direct incentives for retail in communities with fewer than 20,000 residents
- ❖ Hangars, airport maintenance and repair facilities, air cargo facilities related infrastructure located on or adjacent to an airport facility
- ❖ Rail ports, and rail switching facilities

The Slaton City Council has called a SPECIAL ELECTION to terminate the existing City of Slaton Type A Economic Development Corporation and abolish its sales and use tax (being at a rate of one-half of one percent) and, concurrently, authorize the creation of a City of Slaton Type B Economic Development Corporation and the adoption of a sales and use tax at the rate of one-half of one percent to undertake authorized projects as described in Chapter 501 and 505 of the Texas Local Government Code. Correspondingly, if the voters reject the proposition, then the existing Type A corporation and the existing economic development sales tax shall each remain in effect as each presently exists.

**VOTER QUALIFICATIONS**
